Strand's research cover the areas of: fragile states, state and peacebuilding, migration and assisted return, humanitarian aid and development assistance, and corruption and anti-corruption. His geographical foci have centred on Afghanistan, but also the broader Middle East, including Turkey and Cyprus and the political, economic and security roles of USA, Russia and China within these regions. Strand is the author of many consulting reports and academic pieces including [Quiet engagement with the Taliban](#) in *Survival* (2021, with Astri Suhrke).
